Byfleet parish day is an annual event that has been taking place for more than 145 years in the village of Byfleet, Surrey.

As with any event of this nature there are the usual tents and marquees all of which are erected beforehand, and it was whilst erecting the band tent at the 2010 parish day that a problem occurred.

The car carrying the band's equipment was damaged when a strong gust of wind tore the ropes and pole out of the hands of the person erecting the tent and sent the pole crashing into the side of the car, which belonged to a volunteer.
